


## HISTORY

- **2007** AEM Acquired Meadowbank & Cumberland Resources
- **2008 – 2009** Regional Reconnaissance to identify prospective greenstone belts around Meadowbank mine
- **2010** Production begins at Meadowbank
- **2010** Application to NTI and negotiation of a MOU for IVR Mineral Exploration Agreement
- **2010** Acquisition of Meliadine & Comaplex Minerals
- **2013** April, signing of the MEA with NTI for initial 9,330 ha

- Fuller, T. 1977 No-name Lake Belt Geology
- Annesley I. 1979-1980'S PhD GSC/UOO Amer Lake area Woodburn Lake Group Komatiitic suite
- 1989 field work conducted by Wollex on the behalf of Asamer leads to the discovery of the IRV showing by Sandor Surmacz & Marcelle Hauseux (samples up to 21 g/t Au)
- 1989 Asamer Minerals acquires claims IRV 1 to 4 (named under M. Annesley)







2013 INITIAL PROGRAM, A MODEST \$250K BUDGET JULY-AUGUST





2013 PHASE 2 – SEPTEMBER-OCTOBER 10 HOLES 1,759M - \$600K



2014 EXPANDED LAND POSITION TO 40,836 HA AND FLEW AIRBORNE VTEM





## WHALE TAIL ZONE BECOMES THE SHOW DRIVER





DRILL HOLE 79    34.0 TO 60.0M, 8.1 G/T AU OVER 26M









# AMARUQ PROJECT

## PRELIMINARY METALLURGICAL CHARACTERIZATION

**First phase of Metallurgical testing done on the 2013 drill holes on I, V, R zones and on the Whale Tail zone in 2014:**

Preliminary results range from 85 to 95% global gold recovery

Additional testing to be conducted on Whale Tail zone in 2015

Waste rock sampling for PAG determination

Graduated study to be initiated shortly in collaboration with the INRS-GSC to better characterize geological control on the deposit

Ore characterization: sulphide characterization, gold location


Waste characterization: host rock composition, mineralogy, alteration

Structural analysis to better understand folding that seems to control mineralization

## 2015 PROGRAM

- Winter road hauling program March-May
- Diamond drilling program to resume in March (50,000m \$16 M)
- Camp expansion to accommodate +100 people on site
- Resources conversion (inferred to indicated) July
- Preliminary Economic Assessment to orient permitting process (\$5 M)
- Environmental Baseline underway for the permitting of an exploration road to connect Amaruq to Meadowbank mine site


