Agnico Eagle spending with Inuit businesses in 2022 increased by 3% compared to 2021, accounting for 70% of total procurement in 2022.



CONSULTATION & ENGAGEMENT EFFORTS



Despite COVID-19 restriction since January 2020, we conducted over **700** formal community engagement activities while respecting GN guidance including:

- In-person meetings with various organizations,
- · Public events.
- Consultation radio-shows,
- Informational social media campaign,
- Virtual Meeting Room (VMR),
- Coffee & chat and informational booth in the community,
- Integration of consultations activities in Communities Initiatives (Tea tasting, Fishing Derby etc.)

Concerns on flapping of flags on the AWAR as a potential disturbance to migrating caribou.	Bollard were installed on the AWAR between Meliadine Mine and Rankin Inlet in collaboration with HTO.





HOPE BAY – EXPLORATION FOCUS

- Previous operating mode low volume, high cost
 - Not sustainable.

Project concept:

- Annual gold production > 300,000 oz
- Mining simultaneously from Doris and Madrid
- Upgrade Doris process plant and surface infrastructures

Exploration focus:

- Increase resources and reserves at Doris and Madrid
- Boston exploration to start in 2023

Study focus:

- Optimize current production scenario
 - Excludes Boston
 - Minimize CAPEX
- Investigate new technologies, innovation, green energy

- Our focus is to economically extend Meliadine mine and Meadowbank Complex life of mine while advancing the Hope Bay property concept.
- Continue to be a neighbour of choice.
