

Pathfinding and issue resolution for industry

Information Sharing	 Coordinated seven resource development advisory group (RDAG) meetings between 2013 – 2015
Engagement	 Currently working with 12 clients with projects and / or proposed projects in the territory Held over 140 meetings with industry in past two years
Coordination	 Discussing an MOU with the Government of Nunavut on project coordination supporting major projects through cooperation and respectful engagement facilitating effective and transparent regulatory processes optimizing respective opportunities to advance economic development for the people and communities related to major projects
Project Management	 Currently overseeing 11 advanced projects (Pre-EA, EA and Regulatory)
Approvals	 Worked closely with AANDC to move projects through ministerial approvals: Recent approvals: Meliadine, Mary River ERP

Key Functions of the NPMO Consultation Model

A **Crown Consultation Coordinator** (CCC) coordinates all federal regulatory and EA activities on projects consistent with its mandate and provides a **'one project, one window' approach**

The **Crown** (federal and territorial) **relies**, to the extent possible, **on the consultative processes of the Board**

The **Model** is premised on a 'whole of government' approach that **vests greater responsibility for consultation with departmental program staff**

Challenges are being dealt with at 3 levels...

Across the North

Pan-Northern: such as infrastructure, labour market and financing

In high potential regions

Regional: geoscience, land use planning, and baseline environmental data.

In communities near projects

 Community Readiness: community-based planning to maximize positive socio-economic impacts of the projects, and support the environmental assessment process.


