#### **Nunavut Water Board**

- Institution of Public Government (IPG)
   established under Article 13 of the Nunavut
   Agreement
- Responsibilities and powers over the regulation, use, and management of freshwater in the Nunavut Settlement Area





### Legislation

- Nunavut Agreement
- Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act
- Nunavut Waters Regulations





#### **NWB Authorizations**

- Approval without a Licence (less than 50 m<sup>3</sup> per day water required)
- Type "B" Water Licence (between 50 m<sup>3</sup> and 299 m<sup>3</sup> per day water required)
- Type "A" Water Licence (300 m<sup>3</sup> or more per day water required)




