"people are a functional part of a dynamic biophysical environment, and land use cannot be planned and managed without reference to the human community; accordingly, social, cultural and economic endeavours of the human community must be central to land use planning and implementation" NLCA 12.2.1 (a)

"the human community must be central to land use planning and implementation" NLCA 11.2.1(a)






Purpose of the Options and Recommendations



Recommendations from the Options and Recommendations document form the Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan












The Draft Nunavut

on the draft.






Formulation of the Nunavut Land Use Plan NEXT STEPS





Phase 1: The Consultation Phase (Written Submissions and Community Consultations September 7, 2012 – April 11, 2014);







<u>Initial Workshop – September 2013, Cambridge Bay</u> to provide clarity and to inform submissions on the DNLUP.





<u>Written Submissions – February 14, 2014</u>

Parties were encouraged to provide written submissions after the Initial Workshop and before February 14, 2013.

April 11, 2014 will be the last date that NPC staff will receive and consider written comments on the DNLUP ahead of the Public Hearing.



Final Meetings May 2014

NPC staff will contact parties that have provided submissions which require clarification with specific questions.





Phase 2: Preparation of Documents for the Public Hearing





NPC staff will consider the feedback compiled during the public consultation period and prepare a revised Options and Recommendations document and Public Hearing Version of the DNLUP.

These documents will be made available for public consideration in advance of the Public Hearing (June 2014).



Phase 3: Public Hearing (November 2014);





During the Public Hearing, NPC staff will present the updated Public Hearing Version of the DNLUP.





Submissions at the Public Hearing should be focussed on the revised Options and Recommendations Document and Public Hearing Version of the DNLUP.





Following the presentation of the Public Hearing Version of the DNLUP participants will have an opportunity to make representations.





Phase 4: Submission of a Revised DNLUP March 2015





Feedback received during the public consultation process and the Public Hearing will be considered.





Final revisions will be made to the DNLUP as appropriate.





Once complete, the revised DNLUP will be submitted to the appropriate territorial and federal Ministers and the Designated Inuit Organization for approval. At this time the plan is also made available to the public.
